## What's on the Menu? ORPA Select – a Modular Education Initiative

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#### **CONCEPT:**

Recently, the MSK Office of Research and Project Administration (ORPA) has developed and deployed a new outreach initiative called ORPA Select. ORPA Select provides a menu of pre- and post-award education sessions where faculty can choose module(s) they and/or their staff want to attend, as well as how they want to receive it: in customized department-specific sessions or at regularly-scheduled Center-wide presentations.

This information on stakeholders and drivers of the ORPA Select initiative, its development, content, roll-out, and preliminary assessments may provide a framework for similar educational initiatives at other institutions.

# DEVELOPMENT STAKEHOLDERS:

- The research community (MSK faculty and administrators)
- ORPA leadership
- The front-line staff: ORPA's Proposal Development, Grants, and Fund Managers.



## **DEVELOPMENT PROCESS**

- Staff were surveyed re: frequent Pl/admin questions and common grant "mistakes"
- Chairs were interviewed on their faculty's grants/award informational needs
- These suggestions, and feedback from key Center stakeholders, informed the final menu of ORPA Select modules



## CONTENT:

The content fell naturally into three broad categories: "howto / DIY" sessions, populationspecific sessions, and general information.

To brand ORPA Select, a uniform template, slide theme, color palette, and customized ORPA Select icon were created.



## **SELECTION:**

Chairs and administration can request modules to target education of a particular audience (e.g. post-docs, junior faculty, administrative assistants), or that respond to a particular need (e.g. understanding fund balance reports)
