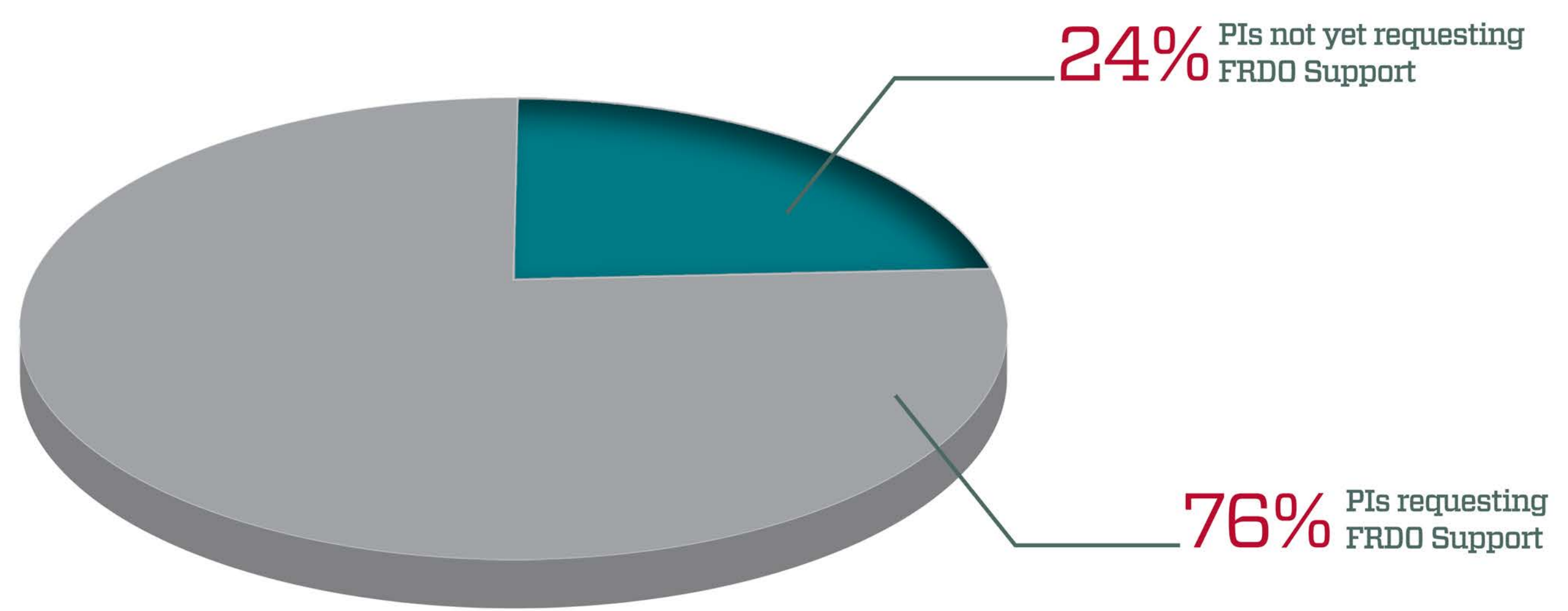
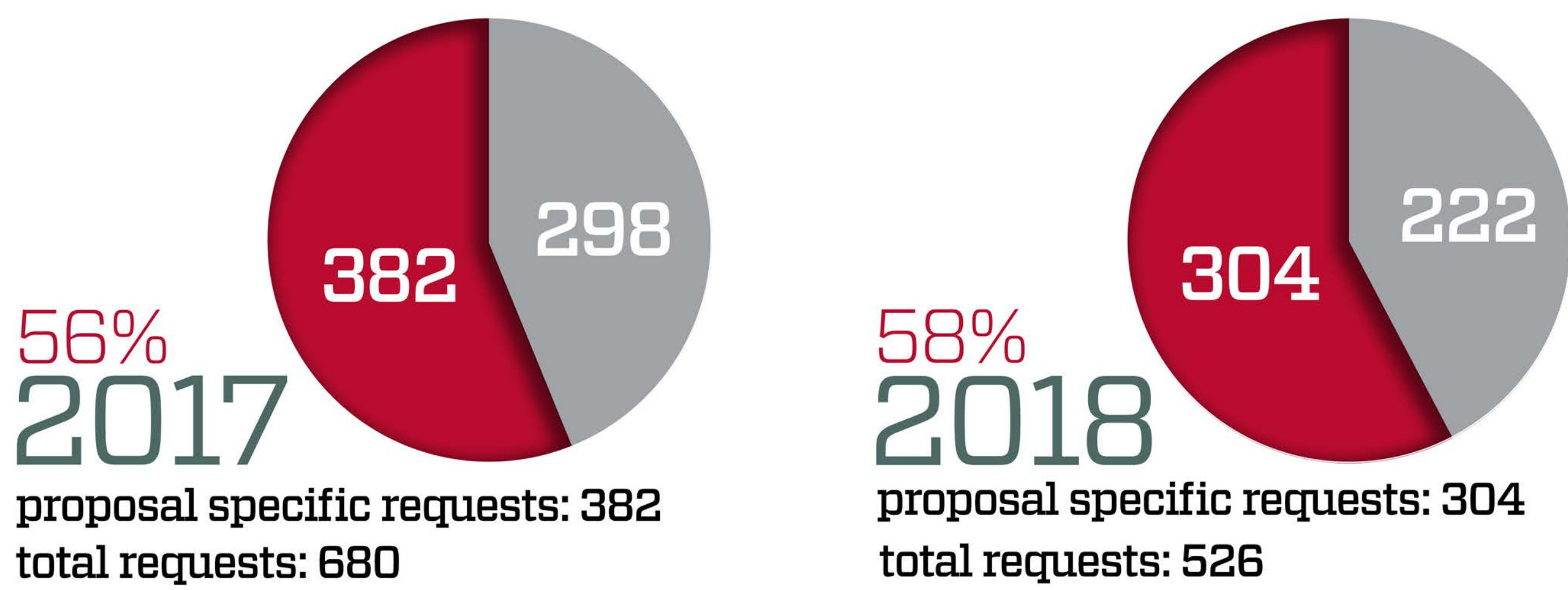


Distribution of Active UNM
PIs using FRDO Support



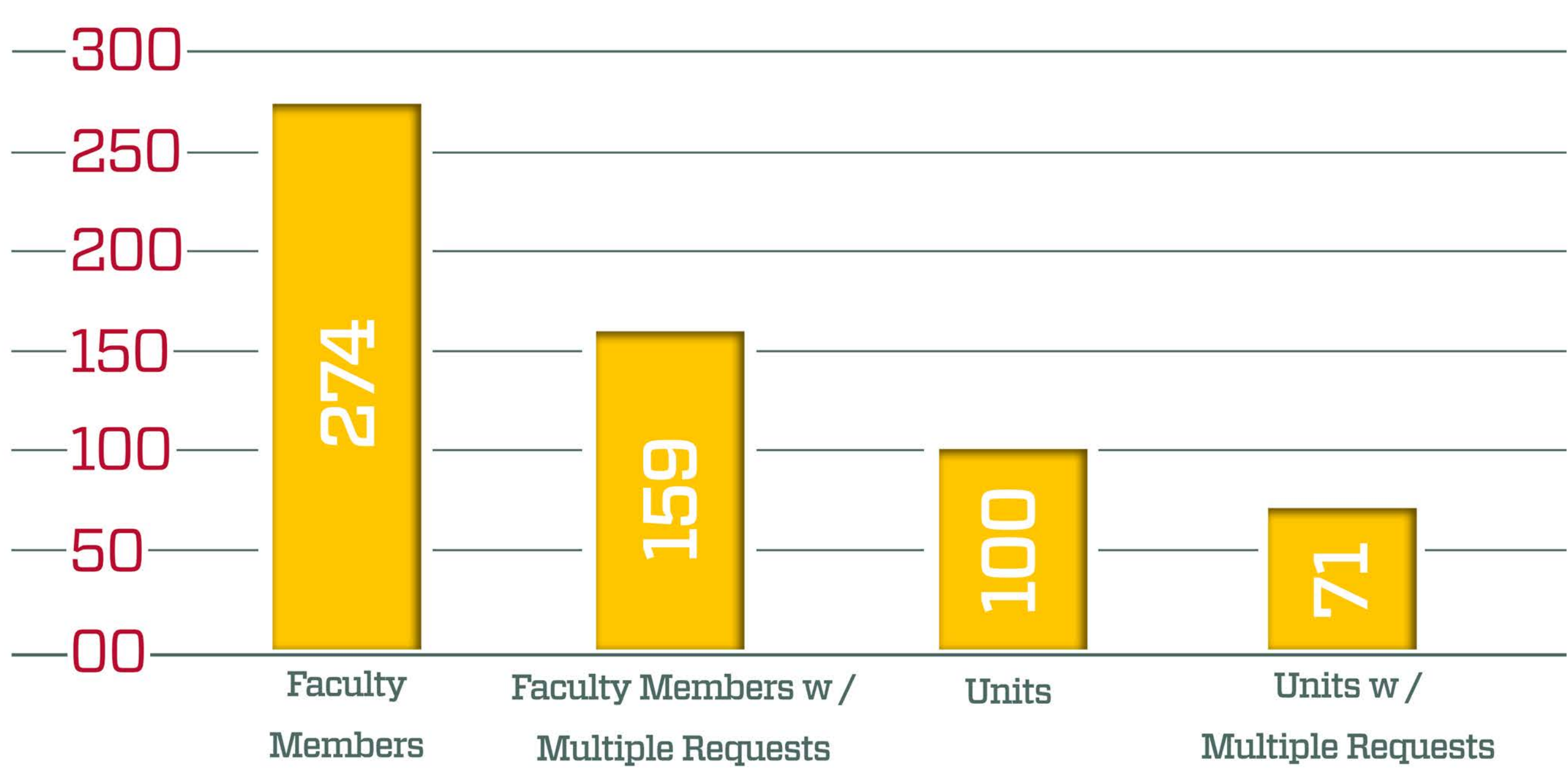
FIRST REQUESTS



TRACKING OUR SUPPORT

1. UNM's Faculty Initiated Research Support Tool (FIRST) is a Vivantio online service management portal used by FRDO since July 2016.
2. FIRST allows research community to request support from the FRDO network.
3. Requests are routed to the RDS assigned to the requestors' college while creating a record used to add information relating to the service provided.
4. FIRST allows sharing of documents and email communication between users.
5. Multiple network members can track individual contributions on a single proposal in collaborative space.
6. Data generated is used to evaluate FRDO effectiveness and identify gaps and areas for possible future initiatives.

FRDO will identify and develop a system to conduct a qualitative analysis on its research support services provided to the UNM community.

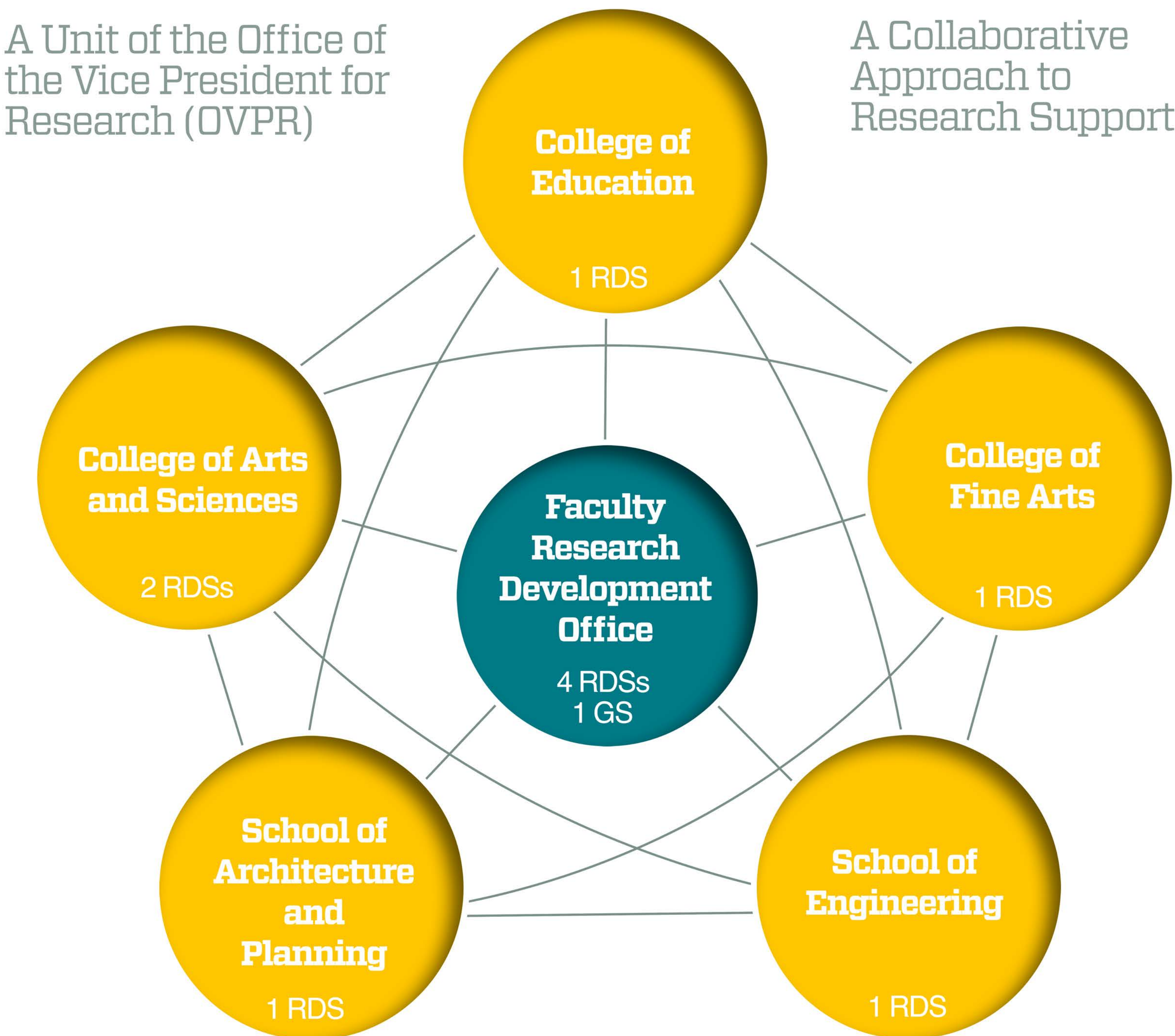

A Collaborative Approach to Research Support



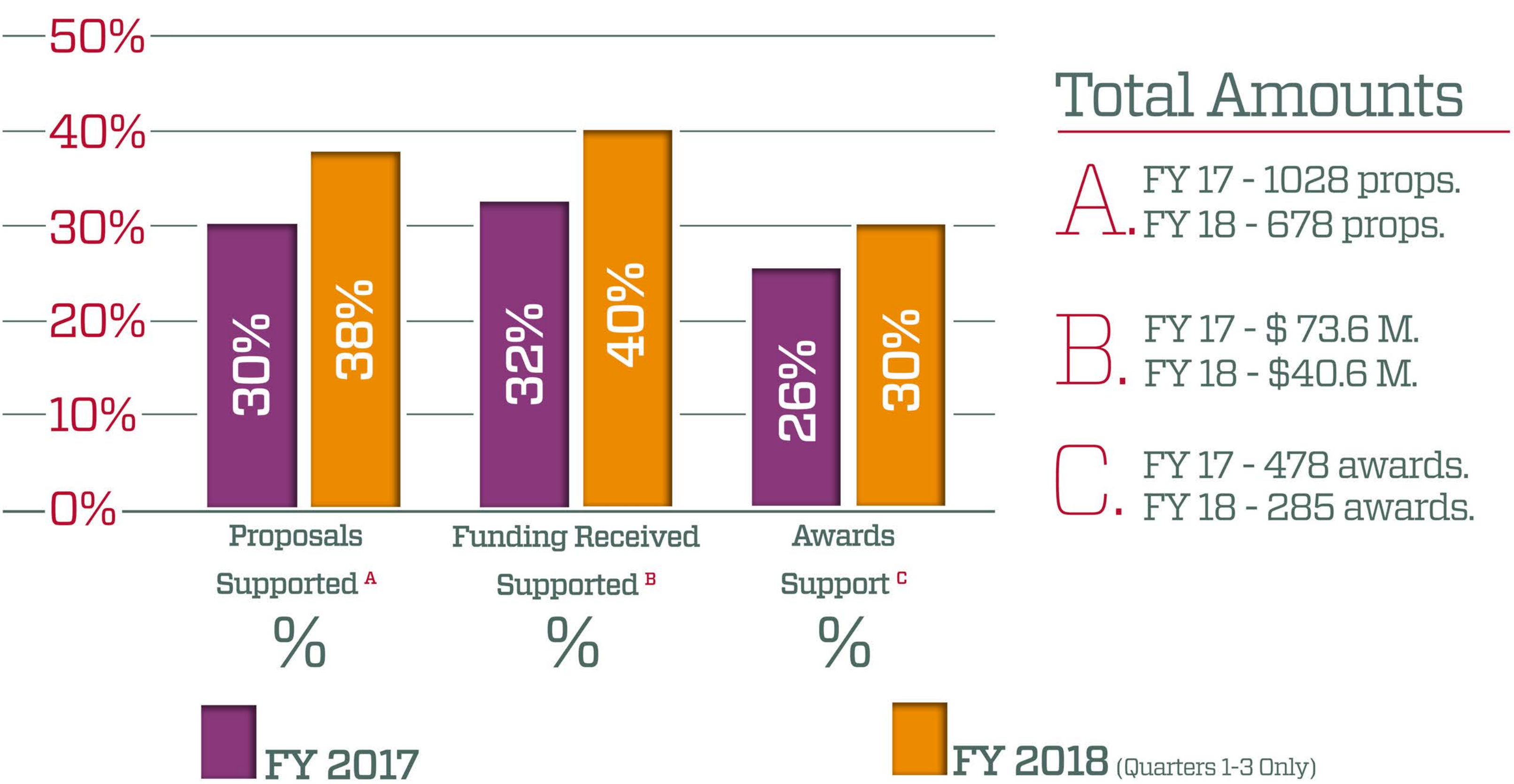
Director and three full-time Research Development Specialists (RDS) and one graduate student work in the central Faculty Research Development Office.

Six other RDS are “embedded” in College/School Deans’ offices.

The embedded RDS focus on the research priorities and needs of the faculty in their school/college while the central RDS support cross-college proposals and special OVPR initiatives.

Network members meet weekly to discuss activities and initiatives and are in frequent contact to address issues that arise and provide back-up to each other as needed.

Measuring FRDO's Effectiveness Since July 2016



Office of Sponsored Projects (OSP) launched a MyReports dashboard tracking system in Summer of 2017 to track proposals submitted and awards received. Past data is available since FY 2013.

FRDO uses that campus wide data to measure percentage of proposals, awards, and funding supported by their network compared to the total numbers.

This comparison is made using FIRST records that include Cayuse (routing and submission system used by UNM) record numbers denoting they are relevant to a submitted proposal.
